

# COMMITTEE NAMED TO PLAN EXCURSION

## Jobbers and Manufacturers Will Make Trade Trip Within Next Two or Three Weeks.

A large committee has been appointed by D. J. Straus, president of the Jobbers and Manufacturers' division of the Chamber of Commerce to arrange for a trade excursion to take place within the next two or three weeks. While announcement has not been made of the route of the excursion, it is rumored a trip will be through the new territory opened by construction of the San Antonio, Uvalde & Gulf railroad.
