

H and H Coffee to Have New Home

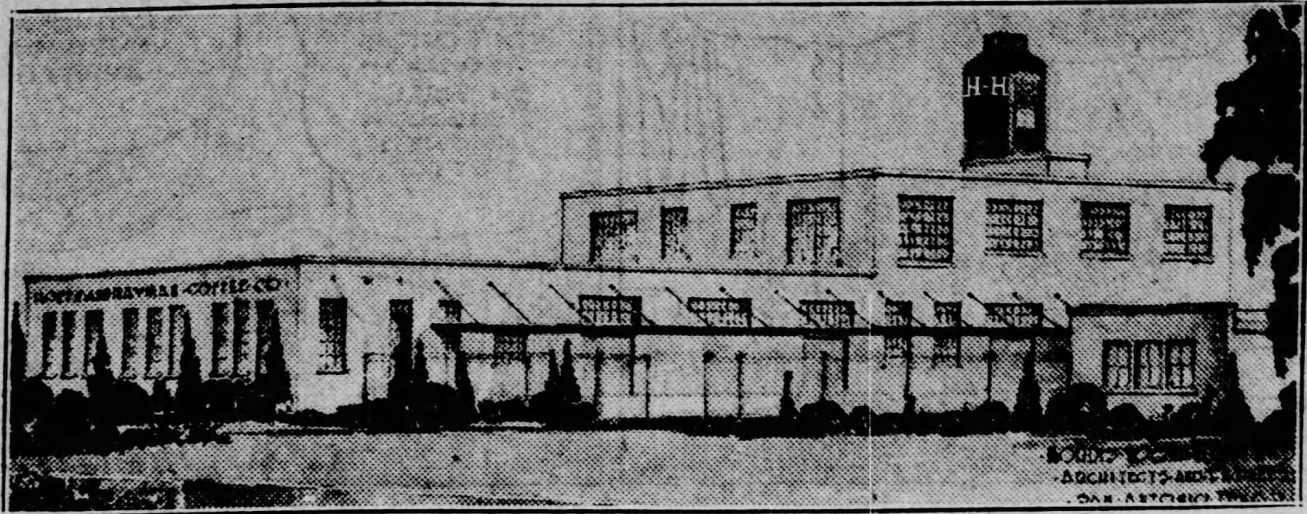


Photo shows architect's drawing of the Hoffmann-Hayman Coffee Company's new plant now under construction on Delaware Street, at Southern Pacific tracks.
