

THREE RIVERS GLASS PLANT REORGANIZED

The reorganization of the Three Rivers Glass company of Three Rivers, Tex., under the name of the Ball Glass corporation, was announced today by William C. Church, local attorney.

The announcement came after a conference between L. L. Bracken, representative of the George A. Ball Manufacturing company, Muncie, Indiana, and Church.

It was disclosed that the plant at Three Rivers had been in the hands of receivers since 1932 and was recently purchased for \$130,000. After an inventory of the plant, which has been shut down for a short time, renewed operation will take place within a few days, Bracken said.

The plant, which will manufacture the types of glassware that are generally used by distributors for liquid foodstuffs, is expected to do upwards of \$500,000 worth of business per year, supplying glassware to Texas, Arkansas, Oklahoma and Louisiana. It will be the only glass manufacturing plant in South Texas, Bracken said.
